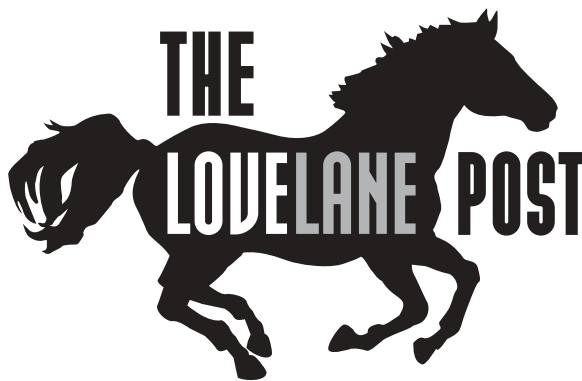


## Endowment Fund Initiated

# Lovelane Moves into New Facility

After 17 years of providing lessons in leased space in the cold, wind, rain, snow and sweltering sun of summer, Lovelane has somewhere to call home. And it is magnificent. Most importantly, our new home includes a huge indoor arena that will keep our students comfortable and dry in the coldest and wettest weather and will provide shade in the heat of the summer when it is too hot to ride in the new outdoor ring. Our new home is state of the art, fully wheelchair accessible, and it is designed especially for our students.

The seeds for this journey were planted almost four years ago when the grandparents of Lovelane student Campbell Grousbeck made an offer to help build an indoor arena so that Campbell and his fellow students would not have to continue to ride in foul weather and mud, and parents would not have to wait in their cars with the heaters on. This was a challenge and an opportunity that was too good to pass up. It took two years to find the right piece of land and another two years to raise the money and to build it, but it was worth the time it took.

The support we received along the way was extraordinary—from the kids who contributed their allowance, to the students at Newton Country Day School who raised \$500, to the \$1 million gift from Kim and Jim Pallotta and the Tudor Investment Company Foundation, and all the other major gifts which paid for the indoor and outdoor arenas, built the stalls and the barn, the hayloft, the office, the grain room, family room and therapy room—and the hundreds of gifts in between. The commitment of so many people is truly remarkable.

In September 2004, we moved in! Even though this was one of those exceptionally cold and snowy New England winters, Campbell and his fellow students no longer need to worry about the weather. Needless to say, none of this would have happened without the dedication and generous support of hundreds of volunteers and generous donors who contributed to our Capital Campaign. To each and every one of you, on behalf of the Lovelane students, their families, and the staff, THANK YOU for our new home. If you have not yet come for a visit, please stop by sometime. We'd love to give you a tour. 🐾

## 5K Road Race, Saturday, September 17, 2005

After a one year vacation, the ever-popular Run for Love returns. Well rested and ready to go, this year's Run features a new date—September instead of July—and a new name, **The Susan McDaniel Run for Love**, in memory of a very special Lovelane student. The 5K Run begins and ends on the Town Green in Weston, and includes an option for those more inclined to walking than running. There is also a Fun Run/Walk half-mile loop around the Town Green (wheelchairs welcome!) and the most exciting event of the morning, a Diaper Dash for those who are still learning (or have only recently learned) to carry themselves upright. But what is perhaps most inspiring about her was the perseverance she showed in defiantly living life during a two year battle with cancer.

When surgery took the coordination from her right hand, she learned to write with her left. When treatments left her exhausted, she insisted upon doing her own stable chores. When her illness sapped the



physical strength necessary to get on a horse, she found great joy in teaching younger students. And today, when she is no longer with us, the entire McDaniel family proudly gives us her name for the Run for Love. 🐾

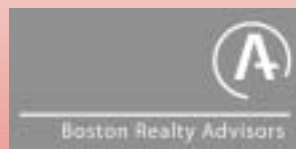

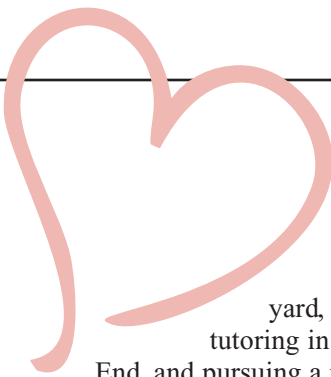

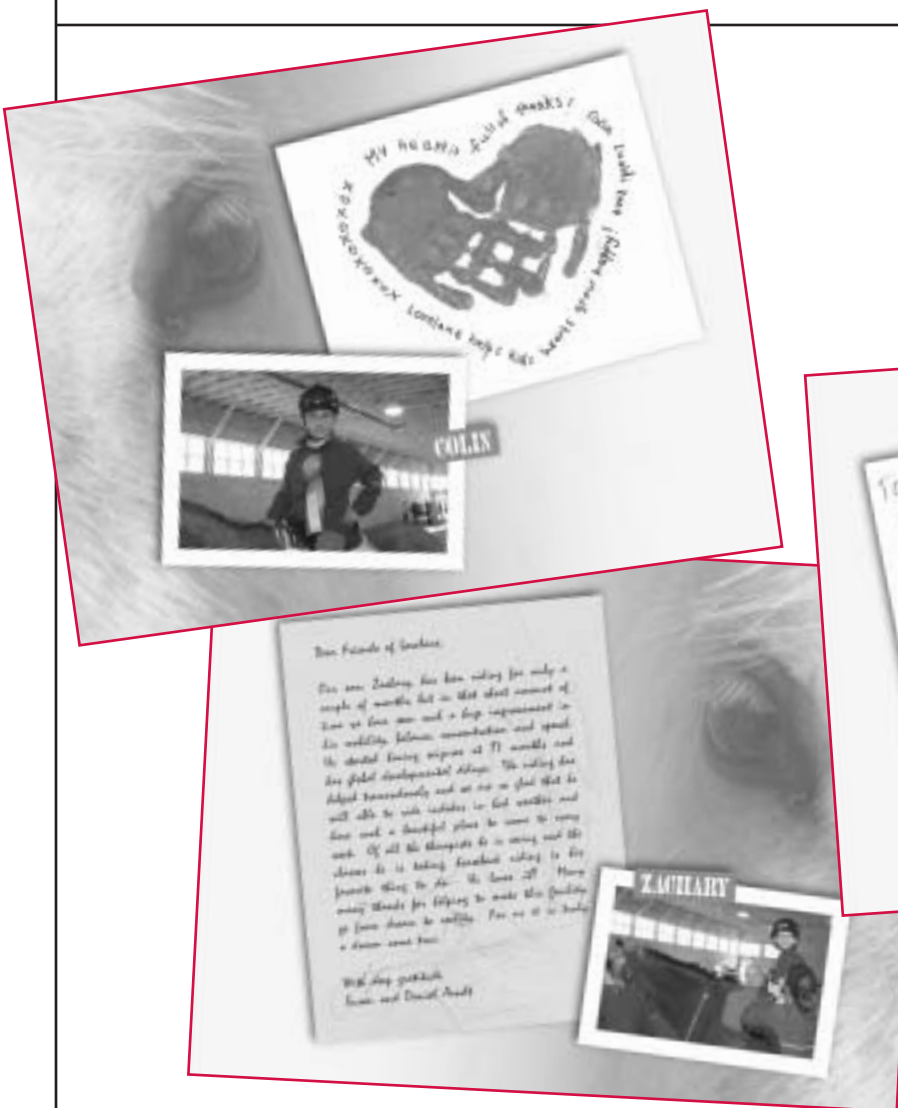
