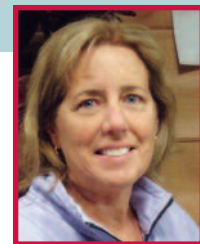

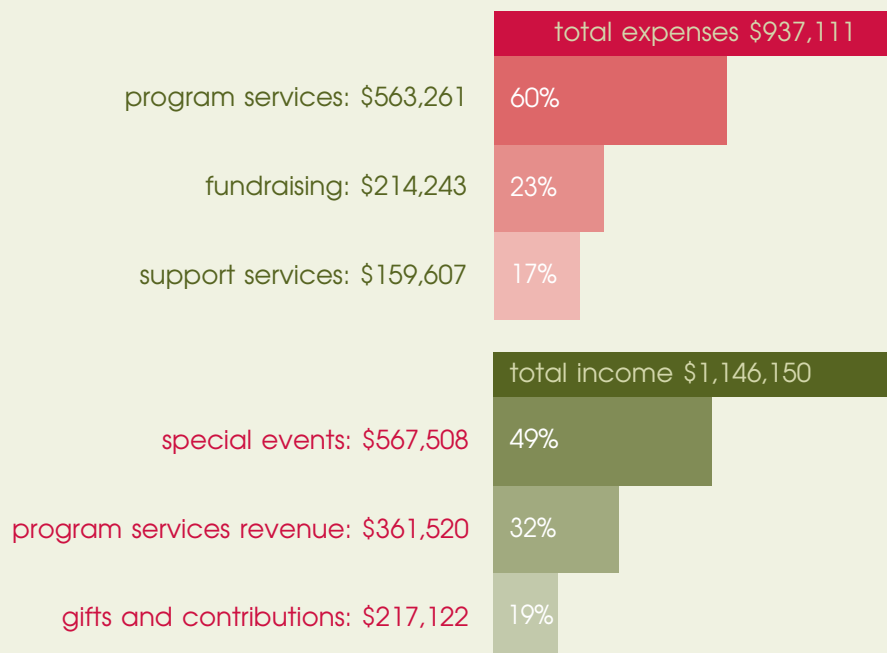

about lovelane

It is difficult to capture in words the essence of what we understand to be The Lovelane Experience. It is the intangible quality that encompasses all we do here; it is our commitment to serving the “whole child” and welcoming every family member as part of the team. It is our effort to provide an integrated therapeutic experience that will both respond to the individual goals of each rider while simultaneously working to improve his or her quality of life outside of the barn. Both on and off the horse, the well-being and progress of each child is carefully nurtured. Every rider is surrounded by love as we ensure that the experience is both therapeutically effective and joyful. Lovelane is a safe place where the collective knowledge and experience of parents, staff, and volunteers is shared enthusiastically, creating both a powerful resource and a welcome respite from the stressors of daily life.



Tuition Assistance . . .

We believe that children should not be denied access to critical and valuable services due to an inability to pay. Since our inception we have embraced the practice of offering tuition assistance to those families who cannot afford our services. Largely unfunded by traditional insurance, therapeutic riding is a particularly costly form of therapy and nearly 40% of our families require some level of assistance. Each year a line item in our operating budget is identified for tuition assistance and a portion of the proceeds from the annual Susan McDaniel Run for Love is earmarked to fund this vital program.



Program Excellence . . .

From autism to rare genetic disorders and from developmental delays to cerebral palsy, the children at Lovelane all live with some kind of significant challenge. *The strength of our program centers on the individualized nature of our lessons, our ongoing commitment to safety and our belief in working hand in hand with our families to meet the personal therapeutic goals of each child.* We believe so firmly in the value of what we do that we work to reach new populations and include individuals who might not otherwise have the opportunity to participate in this experience. This past year we invited students from Mother Caroline Academy to the program, worked with children from Perkins School for the Blind, participated in medical research programs, and designed summer workshops for new populations.

Therapy Team . . .

The core of our program is the therapy team consisting of instructor, volunteers and horse. Each member of the team contributes a vital component to the experience. *We honor our over 70 volunteers who give their time, energy and love selflessly to the children who ride here each week.* Our specially trained horses respond to voice command so that children improve speech and communication skills. Our instructors are well trained, most are certified through North American Riding for the Handicapped Association (NARHA) and some have other professional therapeutic licensure. We promote continuing education opportunities and listen carefully to the needs of every team member as they work to help each student meet his or her therapeutic goal. The recent addition of speech and language pathology consultants has significantly enhanced the team and improved the experience for many of our riders.

Facility Management . . .

Built in 2004 and situated on 5 acres of land, our building was designed expressly and uniquely for special needs children. *We are the stewards of this gift and tasked with its care so that it will still be here for generations of riders to come.* In 2009 we commissioned a Capital Needs Assessment to identify the maintenance and upkeep required for the next ten years. Results show that we will need to spend up to \$60,000 per year on these costs. This fall we replaced the footing in both indoor and outdoor arenas at a cost of \$40,000. Significant repairs were made to the electric fencing and structural improvements were made to our manure area.

Leading the Way...

Stable of Leadership

This year we unveiled Lovelane's new annual giving society; The Stable of Leadership. The Stable recognizes those donors who support us with annual gifts of \$5,000 or more.

Stable donors' leadership gifts reflect a strong commitment to our mission, and an investment in the long-term security and growth of our program. These gifts will create a foundation from which to build a sustainable future for Lovelane's young athletes.

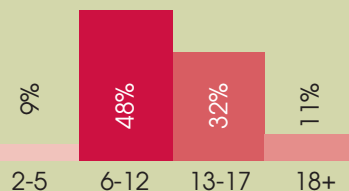
